Pastor's Paragraph: Earlier today at Costco, I was putting a plastic tray of apples into my car when a lady passing by said, "Why, what beautiful apples!" I honestly hadn't thought about the visual aspect of them beyond checking for bruised or discolored areas, so her remark caught me by surprise. Then, as I drove away, my thoughts turned to Galatians 5:22-23 and Paul's list of the various aspects of the fruit of the Spirit ("love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control"). I found some irony in the experience of someone noticing the beauty of the physical fruit that I had while at the same time thinking there was nothing of the fruit of the Spirit on display during our encounter. This is not to say I was in a bad mood or acting poorly otherwise, but that in the process of loading items into my car I couldn't picture some way in which one or more of those nine qualities would have been noticeable in what I was doing. And this led me to further pondering (while still paying close attention to my driving!). Was this God's way of reminding me that there should be more times when love, joy, kindness, etc., were seen in my words and deeds? How often are any of these things a part of who you are before others? We may not always have opportunity to speak the words of the gospel but we can still be salt, light, and a source of good in our world and in God's kingdom as our lives put his kind of fruit front and center as we live our lives. Perhaps each day we could ask God to let a different part of his fruit rise to the forefront in what we do (by the way, these are not nine different "fruits" but rather nine different "aspects" or "facets" of one "fruit," as the word is singular). Then on Saturday and Sunday, seek to showcase two! This may seem a bit contrived but I'd like to believe God wants us to be more proactive in letting our lives display a Spirit-led walk, and this can be one way to do so. You may have a different approach, but let's all strive to let God's fruit be seen more clearly in our lives!

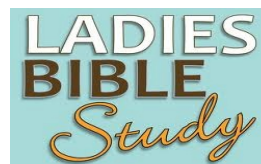
REGULAR WEEKLY ACTIVITIES
