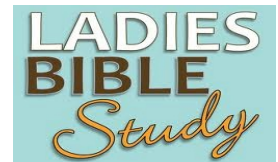

I know I counted at least a dozen individuals helping in one way or another that day. Know, too, that such actions do not go unnoticed by others in our community. I was recently at a funeral when a lady approached me, wanting to be sure she knew of which church I was the pastor. When I told her, she said "Oh yes, I know about that church! You all are so gracious and considerate of others and everyone says what a friendly group of people you are!" Needless to say, my heart swelled just a tad. All this is to encourage you all to continue your good works in the cause of Christ, and to affirm what a joy it is to serve as your pastor. Thank you for showing again and again that "God IS good – and all the time!"

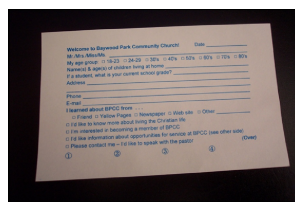
